The goal is the creation of a unifying and harmonious natural indigenous village environment and community, accommodating both individual and natural systems to their mutual benefit. The conservation and rehabilitation of native indigenous vegetation and the promotion of its use in public and private areas, is a valuable objective and will contribute greatly to ecological diversity and habitat creation within the estate.

Local indigenous plants are also important for their role in providing habitat and food for local birds, insects and small mammals as well as their drought resistance and general hardiness to the coastal conditions and fire.

The intention in the greater landscape design is to preserve and rehabilitate the unique qualities of the bushveld landscape.

Residents are to be encouraged to make use of local indigenous plants in their private gardens as far as is practical and to select plants from the recommended plant list attached. The plants can be used in an informal or formal manner, where design theme dictates. A recomended list of indigenous plants is avalible.

Landscape restrictions for home owners

• the gardening and landscaping activities of the an erven owner shall be confined to the physical extent of the pegged residential erven.

• no extension of an erven garden into an adjacent area public open space will be permitted and includes irrigation, plantings, storage, pool equipment, earth mounds or portions of embankments or cut slopes. Infill tree planting may be permitted.

an erven owner or anyone employed by him, shall not remove trees, landscaping or any other plants or natural elements such as rocks or firewood from the public open spaces.
existing trees on an erven can only be removed by the owner should the position of the existing tree be directly in the way of new structures and paving, or if the tree is declared unsafe/unstable.

 kikuyu grass - pennesetum clandestinium - and other invasive grasses are not allowed to be cultivated or planted on an erven.

• cynodon, Stenotaphrum (buffalo grass), or LM are the preferred lawn types.
all declared invasive alien
plants, trees, shrubs and grasses
are not permitted within the
estate and may not be cultivated
or planted in the erven garden
driveways, visitors parking
bays and walkways in the road
facing portion of the property is
to paved with paving materials
as per the Architecture Design
Guidlines

all exterior lighting shall follow the architectural guidelines
any proposed irrigation system shall be connected to the house potable water system with the erven owner responsible for the payment of water usage.
invasive alien vegetation clearance on any underdeveloped erven remains the responsibility of the erven owner and must be undertaken on a quarterly basis failing which the property owner's association will undertake the clearance at the erven owners's expense. • no temporary structures will be permitted within the erven garden, including wendy houses.
